The Word of God foretells us something is alive and active and we in faith know that. If you picked up the Book of Hosea and go to Chapter 11:1- 2a, 4, 8. and start reading from verse one, leaving out the bits that don't speak to you and maybe the passage that speaks to you are these, "When Israel was a child I loved him and I called my son out of Egypt but the more I called to them the further they went from me. I was like someone who lifts an infant close to his cheek and stooping down I feed them with the rains of kindness with loving streams of love." A bit further in the chapter it reads, "Ephraim how can I part with you. Israel how could I give you up." The Word of God is indeed alive. May I suggest that the next time you read these lines of scripture put your own name in. For example, "when Sean was a child, I loved him. When Suzie was a child, I loved her. Take a few moment in reading that passage and **"do a remember when"**.

Try and remember the times when you have known God. When God has been in your life. We know that when we remember the important things, when somebody that matters to each of us, that we feel much closer at the end. Here is an opportunity to remember with God. You will feel much closer to Him at the end, I assure you. When you are remembering you might think that it is you remembering when you were a child loving God. No, no, no. This will be God remembering first! Remembering the first time that he saw you and smile, remembering the times when he first saw your tears. Remembering all the time when you were in strife and you needed him. Remembering all the times that you laughed with him. This passage, Hosea Chapter 11 is **"God's remember when". The invitation is to do just that.**
