SPECIAL PARISH INFORMATION AND ARCHDIOCESAN EVENT

There was a holy Irish monk who was Abbott of Maredsous in Belgium. His name was Don Columba Marmion. During the First World War he went looking for a place to build a safe monastery for his monks. So, without a passport and disguised as a cattle trader he travelled across occupied Europe. When he got to England, he was of course asked for his passport. His reply to the official at the entry of the country was "For sure I am Irish, and no Irishman has a passport unless he is going to hell and I am not going there!" the poor officer was so confused by the statement that he let him in. It gives you some idea of the man. Don Columba wrote several books, "Christ the ideal of the monk. Christ the ideal of the priest among them." In one of his books he says, "God beholds us in his Word in Christ his Incarnate Word." Just picture it, you and I go to the Word of God and we behold God in that Word, we behold his whole self, his love, his compassion, his mercy. We meet him waiting for us. In His Word You find Him telling us all manner of consoling things. "You are precious in my eyes and I love you." "I am doing a new deed even now as it comes to light". Can you see it? "Forgive them Father for they do not know what they are doing." St. Therese of Lisieux always said she had no other guide and so when she wanted to find the answer to anything, she always went to the Word and found it. She found God, Now here is Don Columba going much further and telling us that when God looks into His Word, he finds you and me. He looks through and beyond his Son and finds you and me. He listens to our word and he finds our voice. When you and I listen to the Word of God proclaimed every Sunday God is listening too and he is listening for you. I don't know about you, but it makes me feel so very wanted.

The Commandments of God.

- 1. I am the Lord your God: you shall not have any strange gods before me.
- 2. You shall not take the name of the Lord your God in vain.
- 3. Remember to keep holy the Lord's day.
- 4. Honour your father and mother.
- 5. You shall not kill.
- 6. You shall not commit adultery.
- 7. You shall not steal.
- 8. You shall not bear false witness against your neighbour.
- 9. You shall not covet your neighbour's wife.
- 10. You shall not covet your neighbor's goods.

"This is the first and greatest commandment." Matthew 22:35 ff.

"And to disconcert him one of them put a question, master which is the greatest commandment of the Law? Jesus declared, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the greatest and the first commandment. The second resembles it:

You must love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments hang the whole Law and the Prophets also."

The Principal Commandments of the Church.

- To hear Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of obligation.
- To observe the laws of penance on the days commanded.
- To confess our sins at least once a year.
- To receive worthily the Blessed Eucharist each year at Easter, or within the appointed time.
- To contribute to the support of our pastors and to upkeep of the Catholic schools and charitable institutions.
- To observe the laws of the Church regarding the celebration of the Sacrament of Matrimony.
