Call him God!

In my class whilst at primary school we had a student called Paul. Paul was a weed of a boy. He would not have weighed in no more than 5 kilos. He was the shortest student in all our school. He was like a matchstick with the wood scrapped off. A slight "Freo Doctor" (i.e. sea breeze) would have swept him off across Fremantle Park without any effort. I exaggerate. Paul was a kind meek lad. His father was a truck driver and Paul's big aim in life was to be a "truckie" like his father. So, Paul as small as he was, would swagger into the classroom every morning. He was as soft as butter. When the teacher would tell stories after lunch in class as it was her way, if it was a sad story you could bet your "bottom dollar" that Paul would always cry. But Paul's big aim in life was to be a tough truck driver. So, like his dad he took on the attributes of his father, and his mother took all that on board and let him go until Paul had decided that he would start calling his mother "Carmel" like his father would do. Now Paul had an older sister and younger sister. He was the only little boy in that family and no boy cousins. After listening to herself being called Carmel after a week or two, his mother finally sat him down and said to him, "Now look Paul, there are loads of people who can call me Carmel. Your father calls me Carmel, your aunties call me Carmel, grandma calls me Carmel... but there is only one little boy on the planet who can call me Mum and that's you! If I don't hear it from you Paul, I don't hear it at all and that makes me very sad." Well, she put it in the right way. She only had to say it made her sad and that was enough for Paul to change his ways. I thought often about that. God is like that. Everyone can come and tell God He is the most wonderful thing since sliced bread. Everybody can call out his name and they can call it out in various degrees of devotion and intensity.... But if God does not hear his name mentioned by you or me, we could have saved the trouble. It's our voice he wants to hear. It's the intonation in our voice he wishes to hear, it's the love in our voice which he wants to hear. Make His day. Call Him God today!
