Cathedral Manager required: St Mary's Cathedral is looking for a Cathedral Manager. This position was first instituted when the Cathedral was renovated and reopened in 2009. Reporting to, and working very closely with, the Dean, the primary focus is to manage the day-to-day operations of St Mary's Cathedral, its precinct and the satellite churches it operates within the Cathedral parish. The Manager manages and oversees all three areas of the precinct, namely; Administration and Operations of St Mary's Cathedral, Cathedral House and the Pro Cathedral. Building management and co-ordination of maintenance is a very important part of this role. The Manager will manage Cathedral grounds staff, Cathedral House staff and the operations of the bookshop and piety stall (which is fully run by volunteers). Accountability for a team of 6 people plus numerous volunteers and their management is a key aspect of this role. By negotiation on site accommodation is offered as part of the remuneration package. Full training and comprehensive handover from the incumbent will be provided. The applicant must be a good time manager, able to prioritise and handle multiple tasks and have strong written and verbal communication skills.
