#### Reflection 25th Sunday Ordinary Time Year A 2020

I lost a most beloved friend this year. I got news that she got sick and collapsed but I wasn't alarmed. I was sure that she was going to be alright. During the morning at prayer I asked our heavenly Father for a word and I randomly opened the Scriptures. It fell open at Ecclesiasticus Chapter 2., and my eyes saw the word, "Prepare yourself for an ordeal" I knew then that my dear friend and benefactor was gone. The Father had "tipped" me off before the official word was proclaimed to the rest of the world of her passing into eternal life. I have been ever so grateful to him. I have been thinking about that recently and thinking about all those other times that the Word of God has encouraged and comforted me. Given me direction, confirmed a decision, in fact guided that decision. He has told me over and over again that I am loved and that I am forgiven. I hope that as you ponder upon this sharing, you too may also recall in your own life the times of personal experiences of the revelation of God's love for you.

A fellow called Bernard of Clairvaux, who lived a long time ago says of the Word of God and says to God, "I knew you were present in your Word by the movement of my heart." What a wonderful acclamation of faith in the presence of God in his life. What about you? Does the Word of God move your heart? Can you recall the times of such intimacy of Father's care of you?

As we ponder upon these words from Scripture see which one is meant for you at this moment of your life. "I tell you do not be afraid."

- "Father forgive them".
- "You are precious in my eyes and I love you."
- "May your sins as red as scarlet they shall be as white as snow."
- "Father I want those you have given me to be with me where I am."
