**Obstacles** I was late for an appointment recently and as you might well imagine being late for the appointment meant that I was very much tempted to put my foot down on the accelerator with generosity. Time was ticking by. But as it would happen, I could not put my lead foot down on the accelerator because the car in front of me was going so slowly. I know that you'll find this hard to imagine but there I was drumming away on the steering wheel thinking "Oh please move, oh please, please go faster, Oh please indicate to turn left. The time was quickly passing by. The car in front still wasn't going any the faster. I was stuck! I could not go around it, so I had no alternative but to stay behind it. A bit further up the road what should I spy? A police vehicle. Now you could put two and two together. Had I not got stuck behind that car I would have been caught with a "mandatory" donation to the government coffers and demerit points to boot. It would have been my own fault completely and utterly. But that didn't happen because someone in front of me was going so, so, slowly. Someone in front of me was being an obstacle to what I wanted to do. How many times does that sort of thing happen for you and I, not just on the road but have that somebody in our life who has become an obstacle? How many times are they impossible to get around? How many times do situations turn up that are obstacles? Things that we cannot do anything about, and we are just stuck? We can either rant or rave and carry on the way I was tested to do, or we can say, "Here it is. This is what the Father has allowed in my life now." I might not like it but here is God caring for me. I don't know what it is that God is saving me from. I don't know what God is doing, but I know that I am in God's care, I know that God again is looking after me. It made a difference for me when I stopped and thought about it and certainly made a difference since. Now when things come that I cannot do anything about. Now instead of rallying and carrying on I can be more inclined to say, "Ah, O.K. this is what the Father has allowed, and I'll go with it. I'll stay behind this figuratiye car. This week what is it that the Father will allow in our life. May I suggest don't just look at the big things as they're all in the little things what the Father has allowed. Oh, when the time for the big things to come you'll be amazed at the peace we shall be able to bring to the situation. Our Father, our dear heavenly Father, oh who is so much in our life He isn't setting out to make THINGS TOUGH. He's setting out to set us out on the right road.
