Praying for Somebody Else. A dear friend of mine asked me to pray for him recently. I was moved by the request. I was most happy to do it. He was a special dear friend. He and his young family were in dire straits. I took it very seriously indeed. Throughout the day I saw myself as standing beside him. I saw myself as hanging onto his hand. I saw myself as willing, moving, all the confidence that I have in God's power and love into him. I saw myself moving all my deep convictions that God has everything in hand. "I'll never let us down". I saw myself as moving that into his heart. I saw myself as ensuring up foundations of his faith and it suddenly dawned on me.
