Parish Family Celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) Tuesday 22nd December @ 7.00pm.

The call goes out to the Parishioners of Our Lady of Lourdes. It is said evil thrives when good people do nothing. Christian faith dies when practicing Christians do nothing about it. As I wrote last week, we want every parishioner who can walk, breathe to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Confession) on Tuesday 22nd December at 7.00pm. The Ceremony is a no-frills occasion, duration 40 minutes. Fr. Michael has organised a group of experienced priests, who understand people's difficulties. We don't want people quizzed on sins they've never, ever heard of, it could be considered insulting to decent people. The ceremony basically consists of good music, a prayer, a gospel reading, short examination of conscience, go to a priest, tell your story briefly, receive absolution.
