Mystery Is there an absence in your life? Has someone gone away? Was there once something truly important in your life and is it no longer there? Do you mourn that absence? Do you miss it? Does every day seem a tiny bit emptier because of that absence?

I hope as you are reading these questions you are actually thinking of or in touch with whatever that absence is because absence with a capital "A" comes to all our lives from time to time and it becomes extremely painful.... there is nothing like it! I read something recently which I found to an enormous help.

The writer said "the centre of every absence that there is mystery." Now that makes sense, because at the bottom of absence there is mystery. We don't know where the person has gone. We don't know where the heart is gone. We don't know where our hopes have gone. All we know is that they have gone and there is "mystery". The writer went on to say that, "at the centre of mystery there is a hidden God". I found much comfort in that. There is a hidden God. There is the God who understands what absence has done to us. There is the hidden God who understands that this absence is taking us in a new direction. There is the hidden God who understands that absence is tearing our heart apart. This is why it gave me hope because I thought, well when the absence hits hard, that is only God. That is only God continuing to look after me "BIG TIME". That is God looking after me His way. Puts a whole new perspective on absence. I hope that it does for you to, as together through absence we journey together into the mystery of the hidden God.
