Lent is a penitential season of prayer, self-denial and helping others. In this way, the whole Church prepares for Easter with those who are to be baptised. Catholics are obliged to receive holy communion at least once a year, in Australia between Ash Wednesday and Trinity Sunday.

Ash Wednesday and **Good Friday** are days of fast and abstinence. The Law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year (CCL 97, 1251-52) During Lent **penance** should be not only inward and individual, but also outward and social. **Ash Wednesday Mass 9.00am**
