As we approach the end of the financial year our household's thoughts are concentrated on income and expenses, and the cost-of-living, which we are reminded about at this election time. Those imperatives also heavily impact on our parish finances; we also struggle to meet continually rising costs, especially utilities, Archdiocese assessments and insurances. As you have seen in every edition of the parish bulletin, planned giving donations - the parish's main source of income - **average only 77% of commitments** which is a burden on our parish priest, requiring the most stringent 'house-keeping'. With a strong recommitment, and an increase in pledges it will enable the parish to continue with improvement projects, one example being Lighting on the pathway to, and around the main car-park.
