Easter Greeting Bulletin 2022

Our sorrow has turned into joy! TRUTH has spoken and TRUTH has conquered death. The TRUTH is to be proclaimed! One of the most demonstrative Easter greetings I have ever heard expressed and received was from neighbours who happened to be Greek Orthodox! **Christos anesti! (Christ is Risen).** To which one's response is **Altheos anesti! (Truly, He is Risen).** The Easter cry not only came from their hearts but came up from the soles of their boots!! (There will be no retelling of the sloppy wet kisses from the old grandma, or the abundant hospitality offered thereafter). So many Christian communities also share and express this joy of the Resurrection of Christ with much exuberance. Today as reflect on the Scripture passages. **"Matthew 28:6-7"** ⁶He is not here; he has risen, just as he said. Come and see the place where he lay. ⁷Then go quickly and tell his disciples: 'He has risen from the dead and is going ahead of you into Galilee. There you will see him.' Now I have told you." **Mark 16:6** ⁶But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed; you are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has been raised; he is not here. Look, there is the place they laid him. **Luke 24:34** ³⁴They were saying, "The Lord has risen indeed, and he has appeared to Simon!" We may also take onboard the words of Christos Anesti Hymn, sung after midnight in the Orthodox Easter liturgy. **"Christ is risen from the dead, and by His death He has trampled down death and to those in the tomb he gave eternal life!"** So whatever life has done to us, no matter what mistakes we have made, no matter where we now find ourselves, may the truth and mercy of the Triumph of Christ overtake us.
