Idleness. Idleness, this can be one's single greatest enemy, but an easy place to fall into given human nature and a way of life society purports! One thing you notice when a car is left idle, is that it is going nowhere! and as humans this could be a dangerous place to be. Dangerous, because it could be a breeding ground for thoughts of doubt, fears, temptations, anxiety, theft. We know of course that these are not of God's nature. Left to grow stronger they have a crippling effect on our life. It would be important to mention here that there is a distinction between rest and idleness. Rest is good. It is productive, beneficial, and necessary. Idleness may be seen as contrary to discipline, diligence, attentiveness, creativity, engagement, presence, mindfulness, participation, astuteness, direction, honesty, integrity and purpose. An idle speech maker who lacks control over conversation, will seek to fill the void or voice the opinion which often leads to gossip or criticism of others. Idleness may also be seen as a lack of purposeful action. We lack a plan, some direction, therefore we end up doing nothing, feeling unmotivated, unclear and unproductive which, in turn may lead us to feel that we don't measure up. There are many ways this may play out in our life, but what it is the end consequences that warrant us to look at idleness seriously and address it as soon as possible. Purposeful planning, self-control and digesting words of truth are good places to start to combat idleness. So, we are encouraged to always practice these three things through life.
