Guard your heart

Proverbs 4: 23 says “above all else guard your heart because life comes out from it.” How much weight and attention do we give this simple yet profound directive? Do we guard really and protect that what goes into our heart? Conscious that what goes on in it, must manifest and come out in some shape or form.
