Living Water I remember one hot summers day I was playing netball with a group of friends. It was hot. The mercury had risen beyond the 40C degree mark. When it was time for a break, we got our masks off. Quite clearly, at the venue the proprietors had strategically leased a commercia drink dispensing machine at \$6 per bottle. This better be one magical bottle of flavored water that comes out of the chute. No sooner had I had opened it I drank it down. "I'll have another I thought" Again, it had gone just as quickly as the first. A litre of water in about thirty seconds. Sweating profusely and dehydrated and now out of cash, a friend noticed me. I was starting to slump in a puddle of sweat and obviously looking like I was going to pass out, for I started to buckle at the knees! He came over and did the customary shoulder shake and said, "Hey are you o.k.?" Dazed, a little confused I said, "Could you get me a drink" I ended up drinking another litre or so of water before my body temperature came down. He had exactly what I needed, when I needed it. As Christians our hearts long for not the flavored water but for the living water, which is Jesus and HE, the Good Shepherd offers himself to us! As brothers and sisters there are times when we can't make it to the water on our own. Maybe we have been working too hard for God. Maybe we have been hurt, maybe we have slipped away, and we are ashamed. When we see someone in this place, if all the living water you can carry to them is a handful, then carry a handful. If you can carry a bucket, carry a bucket full and if you can carry them to Jesus Christ, carry them. This week let us be mindful of our sisters and brothers, and the unchurched and struggling parents and their children. We are all in this together.
