Resolution

When talking all things technology, you may have heard the term “resolution” in regard to televisions, screens, cameras and the alike. Very simply the higher the resolution the clearer the image or picture or vision. The word “resolution” is used powerfully in the Scriptures. What first comes to mind is the final weeks of Jesus life. When He turned resolutely towards Jerusalem, he had in his sight what laid before him, and he was resolved to follow through. Nothing could stop the mission of love and salvation written in His very being and death on the Cross that would open the way to heaven.

His vision was clear. His resolution was “high” so to speak and nothing could deter Him.
