#### On the Mat

One of my godchildren teaches little children in another country. She has a wide selection of characters and backgrounds in that class of hers. There is one little lad who is a handful, Let's call him "Ross". One day as the children were going about their activities something happened and little Ross erupted. He physically ripped into the group of children around him. They were terrified and they screamed "Blue murder!" My godchild disentangled him from the group and set him on his own, right away from the others. After a little while when he had quietened down, she went over to him and explained very gently that his behaviour was unacceptable. That the other children had a right to be physically safe in their class. He lifted his tearstained swollen five-year-old face and said to her "But Miss don't I have a right to feel safe too?" She put the pieces together. This little boy lived in constant fear. When his father comes to their house Ross inevitably becomes a human punching bag. Unfortunately, his mother cannot cope on any level at all. And her response to the pain is far from adequate. The school provides Ross with a hot dinner every day because his mother sends him to school with a packet of biscuits and that is all. It broke my godchild's heart to hear him, and I am sure it breaks yours. The rest of the class of course were very unaware of this teacher pupil conversation and when my godchild brought him back to the class and simply said "Ross is very sorry what had happened" she was blown away by the reaction of the class. They automatically moved around and made room for him on the mat and told him to come and sit down with them. Some of them put their arms around him and asked, "Are you alright Ross?" They continued to keep this loving protective eye on Ross. I suspect he feels safe at a school anyway. It makes me wonder how you and I treat the "Rosses" in our own life. I know how God treats them. He moves around and makes room for them and asks them how they are. What a privilege for you and me to join God on the mat with them.
