Joseph's Way -1st January 2023 Mary the Holy Mother of God

Sobbing and loud lamentations are not new to any of us, either in our own lives, the world itself or in those around us. Life can be so unfair, and we have no words to offer comfort. People lose their children, cruel things happen, floods sweep away a lifetime, savings are wiped out. Little children are left in appalling circumstances, and it all seems just too much. Our hearts can't take it! So, we switch off the television, refuse to read the newspapers, avoid the news apps on our mobile phones. We think if we ignore it then the anguish will all go away. There doesn't seem to be any other answer yet there must be, and Joseph provides it. He was in the habit of listening to God and God gave him a dream. If we want a way through life's pain, then it is time to listen to the God who is listening to you.

I knew a woman many years ago, a truly kind and unselfish person. Her alcoholic husband wound up in prison after years of causing abuse. She raised her children on next to nothing, witnessed the early death of her eldest and still she had time for the sorrow of the people around her. A meal would turn up at their door, or a bunch of flowers, a kind word sent, and I marvel. What was her secret? She too listened to God. Spoke to him on a daily basis and together they found a way along the path of pain. That can be so for you too. In fact, you must already be listening, or you would not be taking time to reading this reflection. Here is a little prayer to say often. "Open my heart O Lord and turn it in the direction of You. **Amen.**"
