### “Chose Your Mirror”

“Live by the TRUTH.” A school motto which I saw on a school board which I had passed whilst on my travels. It always reminds me to seek truth in my life.

Have you ever been to a fun park like Luna Park or “Side Show Alley” at the Royal Agricultural Show and engage with the various mirrors? They bend and they twist, manipulate reflection giving you a distorted view of yourself which at the time is or can be amusing. Its amusing part is because we know the truth of our physic and how far from reality these mirrored images are. However, in our internal life the people in our life are the ones who reflect back to us who we are. Particularly influential are their comments, their affirmations, criticisms, acceptance and rejections. Unfortunately, we don’t always find their rejection amazing because we question and doubt our own goodness, beauty and strength. If we want to know the truth about who we are we must start with Christ. Created in the image and likeness of God, loved unconditionally, and destined as sons and daughters of Him.

With this as a starting point we must choose our mirrors. Those who we allow to influence us carefully and with discernment. The mirror we may be taking our cue from may well in fact be warped, bent or covered in residue which ultimately leads to a distorted reflection of our true self. It is not our job to fix those mirrors but to simply choose wisely and always seek truth in your life.
