I read a great story. I'll share it with you, the story goes that there was a village high upon the mountains. The tribe wanted a god and made an image of a god at the end of their village. They believed that one day a miracle would happen. That that same god would come to them in person. Generations passed by no miracle occurred, but the image stayed. Then one day a little boy was born. As soon as he could totter about, he found his way to the image. He was fascinated by it. The villagers there would find him there affixed by it taking in every detail. As he grew the fascination did not abate and as a young man the family would see him there every morning before he set off to work in the fields and every evening until sleep called him home. One day he was walking through the main area which amounted to be the only street in the village. And one by one the people stopped and stared at him; that young man looked just like the image. The same shaped face, the same eyes, the same bearing. The miracle had happened. Their god had come to them, and he was one of their own. The story I believe is repeated over and over again in the life of everyone who takes God seriously.

All we have to do is to spend time to know what God looks like. Go into God and include Him in everything that is ours. Making ourselves familiar with what he does and how he does it. The more we do that the more we become like him and a miracle happens on our streets and in our homes. God comes again to us all. What a sad thing it would be if somebody else who desperately needed to see God missed him because you and I had not taken the simple time to become his mercy, his forgiveness, his patience, his wisdom, his understanding and so become Him in the world. I have the hunch that this entire world right now is looking for just that, longing for the miracle that gives them God.
