Beggar King

I read a wonderful story the other day about Johannes Tauler. He was a German mystic and theologian in the fourteenth century. He was a disciple of a teacher called Meister Eckhart. Meister Eckhart is the one who has left us such insights as "If the only prayer you ever pray to God is "Thank You", it is enough." He also said, "any talk of God that does not bring you comfort is a lie." That one is worth thinking about!! However, our story concerns his disciple Tauler. One day Tauler met a beggar. "God give you a good day my friend" he said. The beggar answered, "I thank God I have never had a bad day." Then Tauler said, "God give you a happy life my friend". To which the beggar replied, "I thank God I am never unhappy." Tauler in amazement said, "What do you mean? "Well," said the beggar "When it rains, I thank God. When I have plenty, I thank God. When I am hungry, I thank God and since God's will is my will and whatever pleases Him pleases me. Why should I say I am unhappy when I am not?" Tauler stopped and looked in astonishment. "Who are you?" he said. "I am a king." the beggar replied. "And where is your kingdom?" asked Tauler. The beggar answered very quietly, "Here, in my heart." It makes me ask how can you and I be more like this beggar? A north English country woman said it well, "I am always happy, and my secret is always to sail the seas but to keep my heart in port." It is as simple as that. Keep our hearts fixed on God. Talk to him constantly. Thank Him for whatever comes your way be it good or seemingly bad. That way God will be for you the anchor of your life. Trust the saints when they say, "once it happens nothing can ever disturb you or if it does it will be a very short duration." St. Augustine said, "Our hearts were made for you O God, and restless are they until they rest in You!" And that decision is yours today.
