There is a big difference between being in love and loving. Once again Jesus calls us back to meditate on the Cross for it is there that we see "True Love" and what true love is and to have the strength to follow his call every day. As we listen to the account of the Passion of Christ we are reminded that the Cross is central to our celebration of the Eucharist. The Crucifixion is a handbook of prayer. It makes prayer easy. Every Christian home should have a crucifix (i.e. a cross with the figure of Christ on it), prominently displayed. It reminds us that we are loved.

The nature of that love is true love. Please I implore you, do not let the devil tell you, as he tried to tell Jesus, that the hard things of life are a sign that the Father has abandoned you. It's a lie. When it is darkest. God is closest! "Be still and know that I am God." "Though I seem to have gone from your sight, I am here." "I leave you only to stay." "Do not be afraid of the future, it is mine now and for all eternity."
