Effects of the Son. Many people welcome some seasons of the year more readily than other. Some welcome the coolness of Winter while others detest the cold and prefer the heat of Summer. It is up to our own liking and personal choice. I asked a number of "Summer lovers" what was it they like about the season. The responses were interesting and included such comments as; "Yes, around Summer I come alive. I enjoy being bathed in sunlight. Some may consider that I am "Solar powered." The sun warms and strengthens it enlivens me. Sumer gives me hope. I tend to do more and am willing to explore more. And "When it is warm and the sun is shining, I ask myself with a jubilant mind, now how can I make the most of this brilliant day?" Yes, I suppose that during such a season people do notice the change in one" persona and physical features. We can observe such details such as one's skin changes colour as a result of the sun's rays being absorbed. The common comment might be given as "Gee you've spent some time in the sun!" as "Aussies" to have acquired the bronzed tanned body seems to be part of the culture. Even though one may not lay around to bake in the sun it is generally accepted that one presumes to be in the sun's life-giving presence. Being in the sun can have effects on one to the extent that people may notice, make comment, and ask questions. So, the question I pose this week surrounds our spiritual level. Does your time in the presence of Jesus Christ, the Son of God have such an effect on you that you have changed to the point that people, even strangers stop to comment on the transformation. Just being in God's presence the Spirit of God woks deeply in us. It drives the transformation from the inside to the outer limits of our being, this transformation becomes visible to others particularly if the look is with the eyes of faith. Time in God's presence must be non-negotiable in our lives. It requires discipline, resolve and regular commitment. But the transformation spiritually and mentally is far greater than the sacrifices of commitment. To start or to refresh your journey in transformation, in this very moment and be awed by God. Be nourished by His Word. He speaks personally to you when His Word is proclaimed, in the telling of the witness of His love for you. Listen serenely, as His Word is broken open. His sending of his Spirit was gift to his Disciples so that their lives be transformed, and they come to understand and proclaim how much love He has for us all.
