A Tree Cannot Fly

We all know that a tree cannot fly. Some would think this is because they don't have wings but there are many objects that do not have wings that are able to fly through the air if the wind is strong enough. The reason why trees cannot fly is because they have roots buried deep beneath the earth. They grip hold of the ground so tightly that the strongest wind cannot move them. Many Christians wonder why they fail to reach the level of holiness that we see in the lives of the great heroes of the Faith. We see some people move powerfully in the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Dear Parishioners. If some are able to increase their pledge, it is certainly a relief to ALL. With a strong recommitment, and an increase in pledges it will enable the parish to continue with improvement projects, one example being Lighting on the pathway to, and around the main car-park.
