Our Lady of Lourdes Parish Analysis of Weekend Mass Timetable

Dear Parishioners, thank you for your participation in the "Current Weekend Mass Time Survey". Seventy-seven response sheets were returned. The overall expression and finding of the survey concerning the duplication of weekend Masses, 67 % of those who participated stated that the Sunday 5.30p.m. Mass be discontinued. It is also noteworthy that the Mass attendance head count, taken over the past 12 months reveals that the Sunday evening Mass is the far least attended of all our parish weekend Masses.

Father has openly received these findings and will respond by informing the Archbishop and his Office of the same. It is regrettable that over some considerable time, for various reasons and due to matters beyond our control, our overall Mass attendance numbers have declined. Sadly, this reality has also been the trend in most of the parishes throughout our Archdiocese.

It is always with good intent of building and maintaining a healthy faith community in our parish and having in mind the celebration of the Sunday Eucharist and the other sacraments of the Church that we have come to the decision of discontinuing the 5.30p.m. Sunday evening Mass as of the last Sunday in January, that is the 29th January 2023.

We commiserate with the select number of parishioners who attend the Sunday evening Mass and who will be saddened by the outcome. We sincerely hope that you will find the goodwill to make one of the other Masses in your Parish to be your new time to celebrate the Eucharist with fellow members of your faith Community. Please be assured that you are still very much part of this Catholic Faith Community. Your presence, worship and witness to Christ with others can only encourage and strengthen your Parish.

Beginning on the 4th February the Parish Weekend Mass Schedule Times will be as follows: Saturday Vigil 6.00p.m. Sunday 8a.m. and 9.30a.m.

Thank you to all the active parishioners who responded to the survey, offering prayers and in the sharing of your insights and wisdom in this process. It has abundantly assisted us to recognise the realities of our Parish today and assist us to go forward.
