**Pastoral Notes.** Lent began on Ash Wednesday. Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of fast and abstinence. The law of fasting binds those who have completed their eighteenth year, until the beginning of their sixtieth year; the law of abstinence binds those who have completed their fourteenth year (CCL97, 1251 *f*). If an individual requires to take sustenance for medical reasons, they are exempt of the rule of Fast, "**Common sense prevails**".

# "Ask and it will be given to you; search, and you will find"

We live in a commercial society that the idea of asking, searching, and knocking, is now replaced with demand and obtain. Unfortunately, this is also an attitude we can apply to our spiritual lives. We no longer cherish the idea of patience and perseverance but look towards the idea of demanding and making ultimatums. When we ask God for things in prayer, most of us have already an idea of how this petition is to be answered, when it will be answered and who and how it will affect. If things go to plan, then we agree that God is a truly loving Father, but when the answer is not to our liking, we are upset and question the very existence and love of God. In fact, we can start acting like spoilt brats. If we profess God to be our loving Father, then we have to also be prepared that, like any parent God may say "no" to a petition or may ask us to persevere and be patient. The whole journey of our life is to constantly seek God, to nourish our relationship with him, and to share that by word and action to our brothers and sisters in faith.

May this week of our Lenten journey be an opportunity for each of us to truly ask God for the graces we need to search for the strength to persevere, carry our cross, knock at the door of mercy, and be welcomed into the loving embrace of Jesus whose *triumph* on the cross has brought
