<p>PROFESSION OF FAITH</p> <p>I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. “God wants it to be known,”

Our God is a creative God and uses many ways to get our attention. Our God is a God that wants to be known and loved. Fr. John Powell, author and priest says that there are five ways through which God can enter and touch our lives. These may include but may not be alluded to.

One: Our Emotions. Being aware of our emotions and movements throughout the day can help us to identify where God is moving in our hearts and in our life. Take time to reflect upon your emotions at the end of each day. What gave you life?

What disturbed you? **Two: Imagination.** When we combine our initiative, with creative expression, it gives birth to new life and engages sacred imagination. **Three: Our Memory.** When we remember aspects of life e.g. where has God worked or where we have been loved, or have experienced powerful transformative circumstances or something continues to come to mind, God may wish to bring something to our attention. **Four: Our Senses.** Our God is a sensual God. God has given us the gift of smell, sight, taste, touch and sound to experience all of life and encounter Him and to draw us close through these gifts. **Five is, Our Will** When we take time to discover the deepest desires of our hearts we often find that they are too what God desires for us. God wants the best for us. When we align our hearts and mind with God's we see a beautiful plan unfold and freedom experiencing life to the full, absent from the many fears that hold us back is ours to enjoy. Take some time to be aware of and play with these and listen to God's guidance through these loving gifts.
