#### SPECIAL PARISH INFORMATION AND ARCHDIOCESAN EVENT

Be good to me! Open my eyes. Instruct me. Give me discernment.

As we explore today's reading, we begin to see the connection between human dignity and the commandments of God. Rather than being an assault to our personal freedoms, the commandment safeguards the common good, and thus the rights of all. In the document Gaudium et Spes, it reminds us "The Church proclaims human rights... there is a temptation to feel that our personal rights are fully maintained only when we are free from every restriction of divine law. But this is the way leading to extinction of human dignity, not preservation" (Item 41). Laws alone, though, are not enough to protect the common good. They are not always obeyed, and some laws even permit acts that threaten the dignity of the human person. When Jesus says "You have heard it said.... But I say to you" he is not abrogating the commandments but showing us a deeper level of conversation that goes beyond mere base level compliance with their demands, and which reveals their true aim. The Church teaches us "the Law of the Gospel fulfills the commandments of the Law... far from abolishing or devaluing the moral prescriptions of the Old Law... is reveals their entire divine and human truth".

The task of the law is to guide us to a change of heart that enables us to act in accord with our dignity as human beings, and also in way safeguard the dignity of others.

**Prayer for the week.** Lord Jesus our teacher, you revealed the law and the prophets to us, and fulfilled and surpassed their understanding of God's will. Lead us first in love and second in obedience to the law. Help us to be like you. You live and reign for ever and ever. Amen.
