Stare at God. I have a very clear memory of the time when I was growing up and as an altar server, when a very notable Bishop came to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation in our Parish. He collared me to the kitchen, he promptly poured two cups of tea from the pot that was on the stove and sent me on the errand of taking the cups of tea, one for the Bishop and one for his assistant, the Master of Ceremonies. Nothing for the poor nuns they were hung out high and dry who were being quizzed. The task was not to be an easy one for I would have had to negotiate stairs, doorways, parents, and mates who were running around, yes, those lucky ones who got to the chocolate cake with the thick frosting on it and the other spoils from the tables before me!! Father, her saw the look on my face and said, "What's wrong?" I was scared if I could get those full cups of tea safely to their destination. It was a fare distance for a young lad of my age to travel with such matter. I coughed up and said to him I was frightened of the possible spillage. And he said to me "That's easy, stare at one and the other one will follow. It will be alright." Now for the life of me I don't know what works but it does. Now if you are looking for God, everything tells you about God and so is that. Sometimes in our lives you and I have to make decisions. You and I are perplexed. You and I don't know which way to go and don't know what to do. We are scared that we'll mess it up. What Father said about the tea fits here too. Stare at God and everything will be alright. Stare at His Word! Stare at WHO HE IS IN YOUR LIFE! Stare at what he has already done in your life. Sit down in silence and stare at HIM in the silence if you want. But STARE AT GOD. You'll be amazed. All that stuff that you worried about, perplexed, uncertain about it will resolve itself because you have put yourself in touch with God. Ahh yes, STARE at God and everything will be alright.
