#### Embracing the Will - the Easter Hope living on.

In his letter to the Romans (see Chapter 8:38ff) St. Paul says a magnificent thing, he says, "For I am certain of this, neither death nor life, no angel or prince, nothing that exits, nothing still to come, not any power, nor height or depth nor any other created thing, can ever come between us or separate from the love of God which is visible in Christ Jesus."

Don't you love it?! It is these words "For I am certain of this" that grabs you. It is such a gift to be certain of anything. "I am certain" gives direction to one's life and somehow instils a confidence. It very much applies to us as Paul suggests here with our life with God. May I suggest in the coming week you actively take time to sit down quietly and before God go through all, the things of which you are certain. "For I am certain of this, you are God! For I am certain of this, you see me as I am, and you love me. For I am certain of this, my tears are not unknown to you. For I am certain of this, you will not let go of me. For I am certain of this: you will always be there for me. For I am certain of this!" Furthermore, when you leave a bit of silence for God to speak it might be possible you know that He is taking your face into His tender hands looking into your eyes and whispering to you. "For I am certain of this my love for you will never leave you. For I am certain of this if you were the only person in the world I would have still come to this world, and I would have just still died for you. For I am certain of this that all is forgiven and forgotten between us. For I am certain of this everything that is important to you, is important to me. For I am certain of this I want nothing more than to be with you for all eternity". For I am certain of this I promise if you do that it will do both you and God a great deal of good.
