In the Book of Genesis beginning Chapter 15 we read the story of our Father in Faith, Abraham. God tells him to go out and count the number of the stars because such will be the number of his descendants. We naturally assume that it must have been night time when God had sent him out, because that of course is the time you would count the stars. But Not so!! A little later we read that the sun is now beginning to set. God sent Abraham out to count those stars when it was daylight and he could not see them. They were there none the less, but he could not see them. Indeed, who of us can see those who have not yet been born. And yet God was asking for total trust from Abraham and he got it. It was as though God was saying "Do you believe I have your best interests at heart? Do you believe that I will bring about all that is good for you no matter how it looks? Do you believe that what I have said to you is in fact truth? Abraham did! When those questions are addressed to us however, we sometimes say in all honesty "No, I don't really believe it. I only believe what I see, and I believe in what I can do for my very own happiness." We can't get away from it. we either trust in God's love for us or we don't.

Thomas More in England had this to say to his beloved daughter, Meg. He was in prison; she was sent to persuade him to come out. His reply went something like this, "Nothing can come but what God wills. I am very sure that whatever that be, however, bad it may seem. It shall indeed be best. Mistrust Him Meg, I will not." We learn to trust by trusting and that in little ways. This is a very good time to start.
