# Fr. Brown 8th January Baptism of our Lord.

The other evening, I saw an episode of "Fr. Brown", that BBC production of the portrayal of a fictious clerical sleuth from some remote English village where clearly the most murderous people on the planet live, given the number of people who never walk out of there alive.

In this particular episode there was a man who many years ago had killed someone and knowingly let someone else be hanged for the crime.

Some years later another murder brought the whole matter in light and the man in question was encouraged by Fr. Brown to turn himself into the police. In the course of the conversation the man told Fr. Brown how guilt had stalked him all his life and told him of the unwise things he had done to drown his guilt. As a result, he confessed that he was frightened. Not just because he knew that he would be hanged himself but more importantly he thought he would end up in hell for all eternity. That God really had to be so disgusted with him that he would not want anything to do with him.

Fr. Brown listened and then said very gently "Well, it may be you are right about the hanging but as for God not wanting you to see you, he already knows what your life has been, and he has never left you. He's been with you all these years and he is with you right now." The man heard the implication which was of course if God has been with him now why would he not be with him when and after the man died 'I think that both you and I can well take on that assurance. God is here and now and knows every facet of our life. Dying is only a matter of seeing Him with fresher and clearer eyes. He has not left us in life, and he won't leave us in death.

We might be tempted to be so filled with remorse or about whatever, that we really believe that God won't want us and yet the truth is exactly as Fr. Brown said, "God is here now'. He shall be there in death and beyond.

I think we do well to pray now for a happy death so that we recognise him when he comes. There is a lot to be said for getting in early.
