The Chandeliers. In my great aunt's home, there were two great chandeliers, one in the hallway and one in the lounge room. My great aunt rarely ever turned them on. She preferred to use the lamps that were easier for her to reach. The electric switch that turned on the chandeliers were a little bit far away. Also, their light was a little ineffective because of the area they were lighting was so vast. They looked good for sure, but they didn't really do the job. Now that she has gone the house has been stripped and her children have taken those chandeliers to their children living in the eastern States. I was sent a photo of aunt's grandchildren and a photo of these fixtures the other day. The chandeliers now happily installed in aunt's granddaughter's small Victorian apartment, I can't believe how good they look. Great aunt would be thrilled. Those chandeliers are tailor made for the old, patterned ceiling and the old world feel of the apartment. A miracle of miracles they give an abundant light over there because the area is smaller. They look good and they do good. So often I think that we are a bit like the chandelier. We look at the world and all that is concern right now, the people locked up in concentration camps in Syria, the starving and dying children in Yemen, the plight of the world refugees, the threat of war, the increase in the use of ice and other drugs, the rise of domestic violence and the list goes on and on. The problem seems so big we not only don't know where to start to make things better. Even if we did, we would consider our poor efforts would not and could not be enough. How often have you and I heard or asked the question so helplessly "What could I do? But that is no excuse for not trying. It's all so overwhelming but it seems to me that the answer is really very simple, stop trying to be the chandelier that lights up the too bigger space. Shine where you are in your apartment of life. Do what you can with what is under your very nose. After all God is content to be the light in the small confines of each one's heart and soul. Imagine how wonderful it would really be if this day, this week, yes, that every day each of us decided and acted upon simply to shine where we are. Now what a light that would be I the world. On this the feast of The Epiphany consider the "Light" they saw on their arrival of seeing the holy Child and what they took away with them and how they may have shared she gift of the revelation to others when they returned to their respective country and homes.
