Even at the age of nine he would come home from school, get his afternoon tea, and then pick up his teddy bear and sit on the lounge in the rumpus room with his faithful companion, Ted, the teddy bear.

One day I turned up and youngster said "What are you doing here? I was taken aback, and his mother said sharply "Adam that is no way to speak to our visitor! Apologise!!". He said he was sorry but there was an air of something that had been missed here for me. Something unspoken, incomplete. Adam went off sadly with his teddy bear might I add, and he didn't even come in and say goodbye when I left. His mother told me later that she asked him "Adam why did you ask our visitor what he was doing here?" He sadly replied "I thought that he had come to play with me. I wanted to show him what I did at school. I thought he might have stayed awhile and have a cup of tea with you". Poor Adam, and poor me.

His enthusiasm came out the wrong way to our sharp, judgemental adult over sensitive ears. Sadly, I missed the goodness of his love in his question. If only I had heard it. Adam was a child and I had caused him grief in not understanding. It's too long ago now to rectify and reassure him of the affection for him. It's made me think though, everyone has a right to my understanding even though they may have not put it well or cloaked it in irritation our just plain bad manners. I would ask myself "Why give anyone cause for hurt, however small when I could so easily at no matter what the cost, spare them that hurt, whether they deserve it or not. Jesus did! He heard; he didn't leave a trail of hurt. If we are asking for the grace, I know he will help us. And the various "Adams" of this world that you and I come across will go to bed at night with a song not a tear. Oh yes, Adam has three sons of his own now and no matter how tired, Adam, the dad is when he comes home from work, there is always time for a play, a time to listen and watch "the show and tell" provided by his sons, and for lots of great hugs.
