"Our God"

Given to a little more time available for spiritual reading because of the constraints of COVID-19 I took up the challenge of reading the Book of Ezekiel, as you would. I read parts that I have not read before or if I have read them, I certainly haven't been aware of what I read now.

I noticed that the recurring line throughout several chapters, was this "And they will know that I am God" God goes off to say "I am going to do this, this and this.... "And they will know that I am God"

Finally God is talking to the Israelites and he says, "I am going to do this, this and this.... and they will know that I am their God". That struck me.... "and they will know that I am their God".

I wonder how many times that we take this reality on board?

I passed a dilapidated church building the other day, and the words fit.... "and they will know that I am their God". Sometimes our families are in a disarray.... "and they will know that I am their God.

And our communities beset with sanctions, bad feelings, bad vibes, bad direction and God says, "and they will know that I am their God".

And if He is their God, if He is our God, then beautifully he has taken on all the characteristics. He has taken on all the identity of that group and of that particular family. He is not afraid to stand out in the middle of the street and to say, "Hello" nor point to us and say "I am their God"

Perhaps this week is the week for us to claim him too, as he has already claimed us. What a wonderful thing to wake up tomorrow and say, "Ah, HE IS OUR GOD!"
