**"Where are you coming From."** The Emmanuel Centre has this year celebrated Mental Health Week with a day of Reflection and Mass on Saturday, 10 October at St Francis Xavier Church in Windsor St, East Perth. World Mental Health Day (WMHD) is a day for global mental health education, awareness and advocacy and is an initiative of the World Federation for Mental Health. This year, the theme is, 'Mental Health begins with me!' At this time, I am reminded of the story of an unfortunate event that occurred in New York, The Bishop shared the story with his congregation. Some poor deranged man threw himself off a bridge, going to his death into the icy river waters below. Subsequently various people were interviewed to comment. A psychiatrist was asked for his input. The doctor talked about the psychiatric state of the mind and various mental issues in the unfortunate man that may have caused this tragedy. He summed it up neatly in the terms of a mental illness. Another was a physicist. He talked about the time that it would have taken for the man to die, the effects of the cold air, the impact of the body on the icy water. He too summed it up neatly according to his own discipline. A priest was asked for his comment, and he talked in the terms of the lack of understanding in the man, his apparent inability to accept the love and help of God. He wondered why this man had been led to take his own life in defiance of the gift of life that God had entrusted to him. He too summed things up according to his own understanding and his own discipline. All the comments were valid in their own way but not complete. The Bishop went on to speak about how indeed we come from our own understandings and backgrounds in all sorts of situations big and small. However, it is more often than not just our perspective rightly or wrongly. It is only God who sees the whole picture. We, however, can come close to that if we are people in tune, familiar with God through the Scriptures and the good example of others then we will be able to see things the way God does. We too can get a glimpse of the whole picture not just our own if we come from the discipline of God that is. Furthermore, everything will speak of God so in the situation of which the Bishop spoke the person who sees things as God does would weep for the utter anguish and despair inside anyone who felt that the taking of their own life was preferable to staying on board. We would find ourselves examining ourselves as to how we treat others. What despair we cause in others. Furthermore, we would find ourselves in touch with the tears of God, with his anguish over his beloved people who hurt so much. Perhaps as we reflect upon the Bishop's story you maybe one of them. This man's life was not in vain! If today, you hear this message and tell it to others. "Have in you" St Paul says, "the mind of Christ."
