There is a recognised illness it is actually been called "Broken Heart Syndrome "I image right now that in the horror that is in Syria people they are not only dying of chemical warfare or bullets or torture they are actually dying from a broken heart.

Anyone who has ever loved knows what a broken heart is all about. Perhaps as you read on you too will know a broken heart. Perhaps a relationship finished, and you are wondering where and how to proceed. Perhaps a son or daughter has left home under unpleasant circumstances. Perhaps you are now sitting in the chair unable to move with the weight of grief that is upon you. Perhaps a job or a career that you have invested in with your whole working life has ended and there has not even been a "thank you" for all those years of service. Perhaps you have brought this broken heart upon yourself. Look, It doesn't matter. A broken heart is a broken heart. Supposedly there is a lot of known remedies for a broken heart. Yes, we are aware that there are lots of ways to dull the pain, alcohol, excesses of every kind, anything that will numb the excruciating and relentless pursuit of this sometimes-unseen agony. But I know only one real remedy and it is take your broken heart to Jesus and tell, him all about it day after day after day, minute after minute if that helps.

In the Beatitudes we are promised "Blessed are those who mourn, they will be comforted. There is a God who puts the kettle on and sits down and says "Tell me about your broken heart. Oh yes, I know you told me about it half an hour ago, but that doesn't matter. Tell me again." God knows we must tell the story over and over again. There is someone else too

we are talking to, the one who died not of wounds and lacerations or affixation but one who died of a broken heart and then rose above it and took us with him. If you continue to talk to him, I promise as others too have testified there will come a day when you will no longer be defined by that broken heart. You will be defined by the new life that was possible because someone bigger and stronger took it from you.
