Jesus you are the Good Shepherd who is always mindful of your Church. Watch over those who are baptised in your name and grant peace and harmony to all families. “Gold and silver, I have not.” As a clever movie plot device that you will often see especially in adventure movies, during the prelist danger one of the major characters usually an innocent man or woman, plucked from their everyday life of normality will have a necklace, a ring or a locket, a journal, something fall from their possession. They’ll recover it and say something like “Ah, that it, it was given to me by my great grandmother, or I have always had it but don’t know where it came from” Fast forward the story to the climax of the movie it turns out that the locket had a key. The necklace had half a medallion that opened a treasure or the journal that contained a secret code that opened hidden mysteries that it all along and didn’t know it. If only they had known the adventure would have been so much easier, which begs the question, do we know what we have? In the Bible after Jesus dies and rises again and returns to the Father in heaven two of his followers Peter and John were going to the Temple in Jerusalem to pray. They encountered a lay man unable to walk who was begging for money. Peter says to him “Silver or gold I do not have but what I do have I give to you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth walk!” All Peter had to give him was his faith. In many situations’ money, friendship, food, a kind word will be the exact thing needed but don’t forget your most powerful tool, your faith. The Good News of the Gospel isn’t just radical human kindness. It is supernatural access through Jesus to the very life of God. This is what you have. Don’t be afraid to give it. Would it not be a great disservice if we failed to give that gift of faith to someone in the need of seeing the face of the Risen Lord whom we carry.
