#### Freedom from fear

Somewhere in the depths of consciousness there is an awareness that we are running out of time. Every second that goes by is another second closer to mortal death. Whether we are conscious of this or not the reality is that this thought haunts us. We have only a certain number of days left in this life. As so, we have a compulsive urge to spend every moment doing what will bring us happiness. But as Christians this thought should have no power over us. The fact that we believe in the Resurrection means that death is not fatal. Because we believe in eternity, we know we will never run the risk of missing out and so while everyone else is trying frantic call to work for their own happiness, we are able to work for the happiness of others.

This is the source of Christian freedom. We had not only been set free from sin but also set free from the fear of time. We do not have to weigh up every decision to see whether the personal benefit will make the cost worthwhile. We can love recklessly. We can love people who will never pay us back. We can take risks helping people when people don't deserve it. If we remind ourselves every day that that death is not fatal, we will begin to discover that true freedom that has been given to us is in the Resurrection.

Our Parish Sacramental Programs are well on their way. We are greatly indebted to our volunteer catechists both PREP and in the College. I ask that you keep these young people and their parents in your prayers. May this time of faith co-journeying be a great blessing of deepening faith.
