These scammers send messages to parishioners saying they are on a meeting and can't talk on the phone, but request assistance urgently; this way encouraging the parishioner to text message and later requesting money.

"Where is Wally?" There is a popular series of children's books called "Where is Wally?" The whole idea is that you have a whole picture filled with people and this is not just any ordinary scene it is normally a picture of absolute chaos! It is full of mess, there are people fighting, spilling things, bumping into each other and the whole idea is that somewhere in the middle of this chaos there is a character called Wally wearing a red and white shirt looking very calm and peaceful. The trick is to be able to look beyond the chaos and find where Wally is in the midst of everything else. Christianity is meant to be a little like a giant game of "Where is Wally" only instead of looking for a guy in red and white stripes we are looking for God. God is not sitting off in some pure and hygienic heaven waiting for us to step away from reality to find him. He has come to us into our mess so that we can find him here. When Jesus was born, he was born in a cattle shed full of noise and the stench of animals. If your family sometimes feels a bit like that then you'll need to know that Christ is there, right there with you. You'll just have to be able to find him in that place. When Jesus rises from the dead and appears to his disciples, they are scared, they are hiding out of fear, they are grieving, and some are filled with doubt but that is where they find him. Sometimes we are so convinced that God has abandoned us that we fail to see that He is standing right in front of us. He is there! He is always there! We need to pray for the grace to see him in our midst and encounter him in every situation in our life.
