#### Giver of Life.

I remember one of the mothers telling me the story when their child returned for school one day after having been on a science excursion. Her child returned quite frightened. At the evening meal the father picked up the sense that not all was at rights with the lad. He asked his son about the day. It transpired that the little boy had been told all the wonders of a particular machine that they had seen, and he was worried that the machine would take over the world, come walking down the street into his house, own his life. His father listened attentively and with great patience as the little one needed to be listened to and then he said. "Did it have an electric plug? Did it have an on, off button?" "Yeah "was the reply from the little boy. Then, said his father, "You could always unplug it and turn it off. You're in charge, not the machine." A smile of sheer relief broke out on the little boy's face. "Yeah" he said and undisturbed continued to tuck into his dinner. I think sometimes we forget that God is the creator of all life, not mankind. Whatever "life" (note in comas), we give to anything, a vacuum cleaner, a computer whatever it is always short lived because life in its eternal, perpetual form as we have it is not ours to give. We talk about giving life to our children, but we don't. The life that we have been given passes to them and it is passed to us from people who have gone before us. If you go back far enough, you see that life originally comes from God. Furthermore, look around you, we are surrounded by the life of God even down to the smallest mosquito. It too has life given to it by God. Make yourself an observer of life this week because God is always and ultimately the giver of life and He's doing it still. It is a free gift! So, as I said make yourself an observer of life this week and see how much life there is all around you over which you and I have absolutely no control.
