**Relics of St John Bosco in Perth. 15th to 20th September.** In 1923 a small group of Salesians, including a bishop, priests and brothers, arrived at the Port of Fremantle. To mark the centenary of the Salesians in Australia the decision was taken to bring an effigy of Don Bosco's body, encased with some of his relics, to Australia and to organise a pilgrimage of these relics to places which have a connection to the Salesians. **Renewing your mind** "Do not model your behaviour on the contemporary world but let the renewing of your mind transform you." This is a powerful and challenging verse found in the Scriptures, the capacity to renew our mind and how one sees and perceive things comes from an ever-growing relationship with God. The more time we spend with God, the more one sees things from God's perspective, sharing His heart and mind. I guess it is like spending time with a close friend. You know when you meet up for "coffee" or a meal and there is no time restrictions or limits. You are free to chat, to learn to listen until you understand and get an insight as how your close friend experiences life. Sometimes you hear yourself saying "Ha! I've never looked at it that way" or "Hmm, that's refreshing" A good place to start in renewing our mind is to remember that what you look for you will find. If someone says to you that a particular person in your family circle of or workplace is lazy or has a bad name, no doubt you will start to see evidence to support the claim and the list grows. However, if you transform your thinking and commit to looking for ways in which that same person is helpful or generous. I have no doubt you will find evidence to support this too. It may even open a whole new relationship with that person, a common ground. Your expressed gratitude in these areas may even encourage them to be more active or engaged. This rings true for how we see ourselves too. This week you might look for evidence in your own life to support the truth that you are loved as a son and daughter of God, chosen and called, blest with a gift that no one else can offer, capable, loved, generous, abundant, joy filled, creative, helpful, nurturing, strong, committed. Surprise yourself, see yourself as God sees you.
