Gift of Silence. "Be still and know that I am God". When I think of being still, I find it closely linked with being silent. Silence is a rare thing in our life these days. It plays a crucial part in our wellbeing and something we will do well to pursue with diligence in our lives. Are you comfortable with silence in your life? Are you able to listen with your whole mind, body and soul? I find it fascinating that the word "silent" and "listen" contain the same letters and both find life in each other. Both silence and listen are a gift. One that we can receive but also one that we can give. There are several aspects of our being that is good to learn and to be still. Not to give us space but to attune our ear to what God might be saying through these areas. Listening to our body, our emotions, listening to our thoughts, listening to the words of others and seeking to understand. Pondering upon the Scriptures silently in our hearts. Allowing time for the Holy Spirit to do His work in opening our ears to the proclaimed Scriptures at our Eucharist. Having a small verse that we carry each day with us. Allowing our daily events to bring it to life. For example, "I was thirsty, and you gave me to drink." Who was thirsty in my life? Who is asking me to refresh them with my presence, my words, my encouragement, my service in this moment? Take sometime today to practice being silent or adding some silence in your life and with all God's gifts and virtues the more you cultivate this rare and precious gift in your life the more fruit you will see.
