"Why have you Abandoned me? I was talking to a woman once, as if I have not spoken to a woman before. This particular woman had lost a two-year-old son, worse thing that could happen to anybody. As a result of losing this little child the "wheels came off the cart" of her life good and proper. The marriage was in trouble, everything was in trouble and worse of all she felt abandoned by God, by everybody. On this particular Sunday she said to God "Right, I am going to Church but if I don't hear from you, if I don't get any comfort... that's it we are through, and I am not coming back!!!" She sat up the front and along came in her pastor. He spoke the words of God and the words of God were these "My God my God why have you abounded me?" She said she sat in the pew and cried and cried. For her this was God saying to her "You thought that I abandoned you, didn't you? You thought that I didn't know. You thought that all those tears you were crying meant absolutely nothing to me, that I didn't care. You thought that I didn't know. But I do know. I cried every one of those tears with you and I am still doing it. You thought I didn't care. I'm breaking my heart and I am sorry. You didn't ask for this. I wish I could explain it to you, and I wish I could make sense of it. I wish I could make it easier, but I can't. I just need you to know I am here. I do know, you're not on your own. I am with you." For that woman the Word of God did what it supposed to do. It engaged with her life. She was a changed woman after that. The Word of God has power to speak to you this week too. You might just get a big surprise when you open up the Word of God. It will speak directly to where you are most hurting, to where you are most happiest even! Do yourself a favour this week. At least once open up the Scriptures and take on board whatever message of comfort you find in there.
