Phew, it must have been a particularly "bad hair day" that day for my great aunt. I mulled over this and thought what is it that makes a person officially awesome? Surely, not a word game. Have you had someone do something kind for you and got you out of all kinds of trouble of whatever kind? I remember someone telling me how particularly low they felt once. She was heavily pregnant at the time, and she was wheeling the stroller with two youngsters with in it, going past a neighbours' house and as good fortune would have it, the neighbour appeared and simply said "Fancy a cuppa?!" That was the beginning of a lifesaving turn around. My friend would say to this day that her neighbour was "officially awesome". Make a mental note sometime. "Who in your life is officially awesome? And what of God? What is it that makes God officially awesome? Surely it is His fidelity to you and me. His willingness to give us a start every day. His presence in our lives. His love for us that makes Him officially awesome. I guess I can be grateful to a human built iPad which is only reminding me of an awesome story. We don't have to succeed in anything. Because of God's love and its effect in our lives, you and I are all officially awesome.
