Did you hear that? Have you ever gone on a road trip, car full of people, people talking to each other, radio blaring and you hear a strange noise. Maybe a rattle, something unexpected. You silence the music; you ask everyone to quiet down, and you listen intently. You say "Can anyone hear that? What is that? Where is it coming from? In our lives if only we could sometimes be quiet enough so that we can hear the sound underneath all the noise. It probably takes a few requests to get it to a point of silence so that we can hear the hum of the engine, so that we can hear the rattle. Perhaps it is a small rock in the wheel, a hanging exhaust pipe occasionally hitting the road. We have become so accustomed to the noise in our lives that often we just hope we don't miss anything that is important. What would silence sound like in your life right now? What would it be like if we all stopped and listened? Pause for ten minutes. Silence is powerful and is also uncomfortable, it is unnerving. You see silence is that incredible place of humility and vulnerability where we find the end of all our attempts to fill in the space and we just wait on God. As the psalmist says, "My soul waits in silence for God only for my hope is from Him." This week don't be afraid to make space for silence and to listen. At first, we may only listen with our ear but that is O.K., and it is a good thing also. But in time we learn to listen with our heart, and we will hear God speaking in the still small quiet voice that calms storms and brings the dead to life.
