Don't run your car on empty tank. Each has their own capacity and knowledge about cars. But there is one thing that we should never do, is to let your car run on an empty tank too often. Firstly, you don't want to run out of petrol when you are out and about, that is obvious. You also don't want to be in an emergency situation and jump into the car and find the fuel gauge, indicator sitting right above the empty line. Perhaps there won't be enough time to stop at the petrol station. But the reason most people might have heard is that running your car on an empty tank can cause junk, sediment at the bottom of the tank to be sucked up by the fuel line and in turn cause damage to the car. We are not too dissimilar to cars. What is your faith maintenance strategy? Sure, you might have the milestone - kilometre service. Maybe once a year take the old faith down to the mechanic for a major service. Maybe you adjust the sin brakes, replace the theology wipers, get the expert to check the engine. Maybe in your faith life this is a retreat or a conference, but we cannot visit the mechanic every week... apart from anything else it is too expensive. So, what do you do in the meantime? As best we can we drive around on tanks that at least are not empty.

In the letter to the Ephesians, Paul pleads with us to be filled with the Holy Spirit. Now, it is not a new revelation in biblical scholarship that the English fails terribly in the translation of this verse. The Greek of "be filled with the Holy Spirit" is in the present imperative tense. What that means is that probably more accurate to say "Go on being filled with the Holy Spirit. Or "Keep being filled with the Holy Spirit." If you look at the Book of Acts, the author makes special note to remind us that almost any time someone speaks it is because they have just been filled with the Holy Spirit. Over and over again it says things like ... "Zacharias was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied." Or "Then Peter filled with the Holy Spirit said to them...." "Later in the Acts it says, "and the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit." One of the most ancient prayers of the Church, older than any creed or doctrine is "Come Holy Spirit" There is no better time to visit the petrol station for a top up. In fact, you can go right now, wherever you are you can pray this prayer "In the name of Jesus the Christ come Holy Spirit. Amen."
