Making Judgement

In an old autobiography by a man named Gilbert Frankau we read a very telling story. He came from money and from a certain social class and his mother was noted for the parties she held. They always included the most brilliant people. They always came to their mother's house at her invitation. One day his mother arranged for some entrainment for her guests. So, she engaged a young Australian soprano to sing. After the performance Gilbert's mother said with utter disdain "What an appalling voice! She ought to be muzzled and never allowed to sing again." The young singer's name was Nellie Melba, eventually known as Dame Nellie Melba, famous world renown opera singer. Gilbert himself was producing a play. He sent to a theatrical agency for a young male actor to play the lead male role. The young man was tested and interviewed. After the test Gilbert telephoned the agent "That man will never do." he said "He can't act. He'll never be able to act. You better tell him to find another profession before he starves. By the way tell me his name again so I can cross him off my list." The actor's name was Laurence Olivier, eventually Lord Olivier, another world renown thespian. Furthermore, you know we can also make the most appalling judgements of others. For God in his great love never makes of you and me. There is another story of a pilot who was badly injured during WWI. His name was Colin Knox. He and his friend were decorated for bravery by King George V. On the very day they were given their award at Buckingham Palace, they changed out of their uniforms and got into their civies and went off to have lunch. While they were sitting in the restaurant a girl came up to them and handed them each a white feather, the symbol in those days of cowardness and refusal to fight for King and country, simply because she had seen them as young men not in uniform. Judgement, judgement, judgement! Wonderfully God never does that to you and me. God totally gets why we do the things we do. God totally knows what is in us even when we appear to others to sing with an appalling voice or seen to be inept in what we do. In the gospels Jesus never needed any evidence about anyone. He knew what they had in them. Other people might write us off but never God. And even when it looks as though when you and I have got it wrong, God has other standards of what is right and wrong. God does not judge by appearances. I have a feeling that whenever you and I refuse to write someone off or judge them we are in fact giving God more reason to claim us.
